

## EXHIBITION OF JAPANESE SAMURAI DOLLS AT THE MARIDON MUSEUM

The Maridon Museum is featuring a new exhibit of (18) Japanese Samurai dolls.

The museum's Collections/Exhibit Committee: Ann Miller, Carole Fruestorfer and Cyndy Sweeney designed the exhibit which will be on display in the museum's multi-purpose room through this summer.

The dolls were purchased by museum benefactor Mary H. Phillips in 2005 and recently underwent conservation by Rhonda Wozniak, Objects Conservator. This is the first time they are being exhibited at the museum.
